**INSTALLATION GUIDE**

- After purchasing the **Rootways Chase Paymentech Module** extension you will receive an email from us with your Domain License Key. Use this Domain and License Key for activating extension for your Magento website. If you haven't received any email please contact our support team by emailing at [help@rootways.com](mailto:help@rootways.com) (**Note:** Please read our License [Terms and Conditions](#) carefully before using our products.)
- Use FTP Client (e.g. FileZilla or WinSCP) to upload all files and folders of the extension to your Magento site. After connecting to your website using FTP create “Rootways” directory under app/code/ then create “Chase” directory under app/code/Rootways.
- After creating directories, extract extension zip file and upload under app/code/Rootways/Chase directory.
- After uploading, run this command from SSH `php bin/magento setup:upgrade`
- After running above script, you can see Chase Paymentech Payment method at payment method section of admin.

- Login to your chase virtual terminal using this link <https://securevar.paymentech.com/manager>

- Go to “ADMIN” and then do the settings as show in the following screenshot.
