



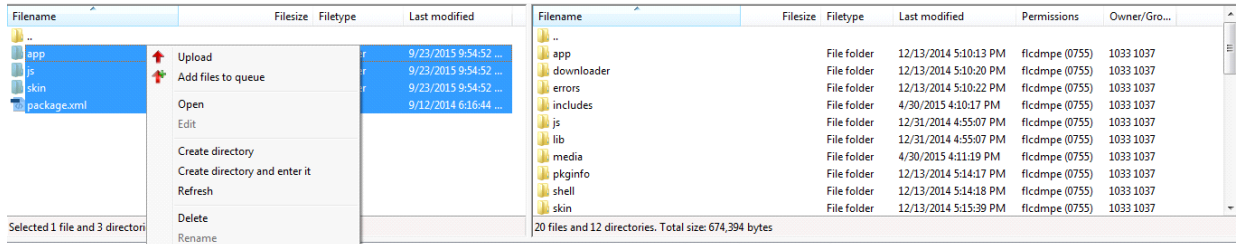

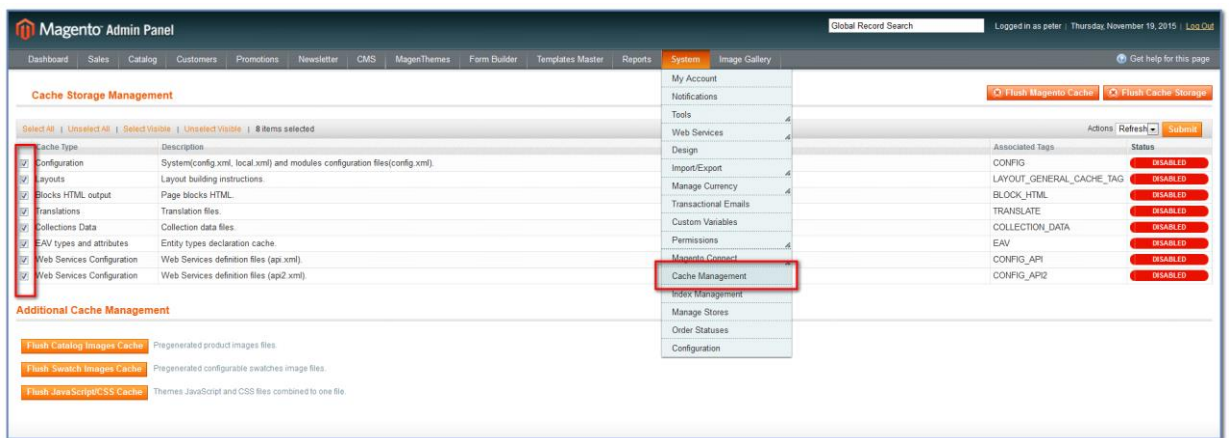

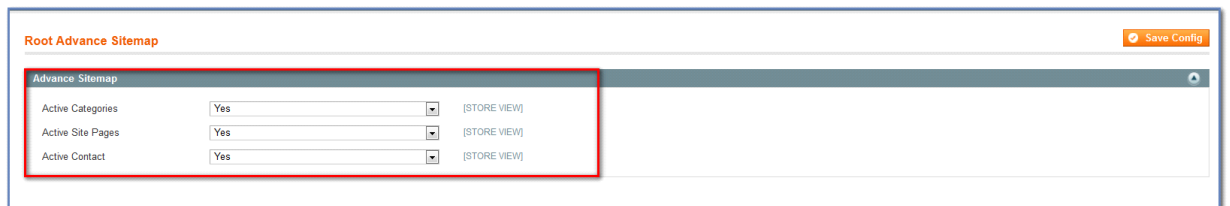
- Use FTP Client (e.g. FileZilla or WinSCP) to upload all files and folders of the extension to your Magento site's root directory. This will not overwrite any existing Magento files; it will just add new files to your Magento installation.



- After uploading, login in to your Magento Admin panel and refresh cache. Go to **System** → **Cache Management**, select all cache types and under **Action** dropdown select **'Refresh'** and then **Submit**.



- Navigate to **System** → **Configuration**. If you see **Root Advance Sitemap** tab in the left column then it's installed properly.



- By clicking on Root Advance Sitemap tab if you get 404 page not found error, you need to log out from **Admin** and log in again. This should resolve 404 error.
- Go to front end and type your website name slash sitemap.
For Ex: www.yourwebsite.com/sitemap
- In your Admin panel category list, you have an option to display on sitemap particular category and CMS page. You can skip particular category and CMS page.
